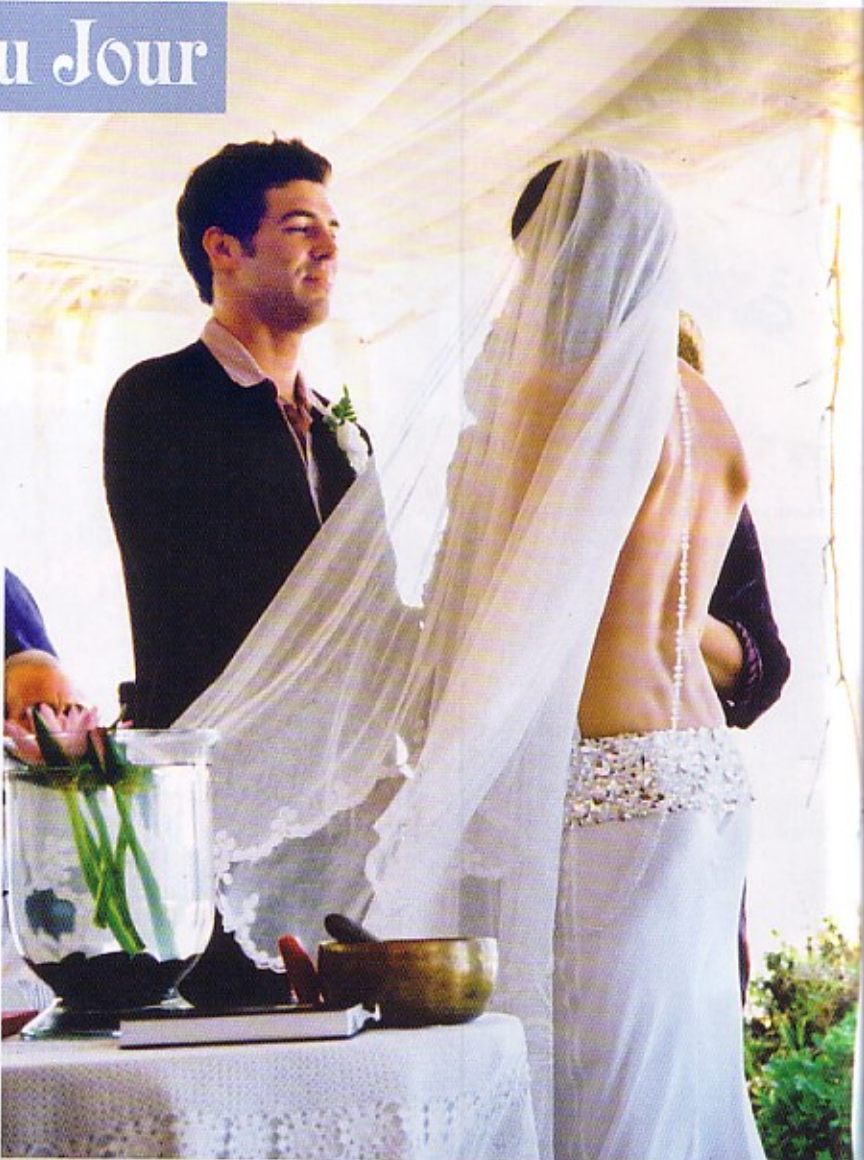

FAVOURS "We didn't have time to organise any, but we sent everyone a photograph."

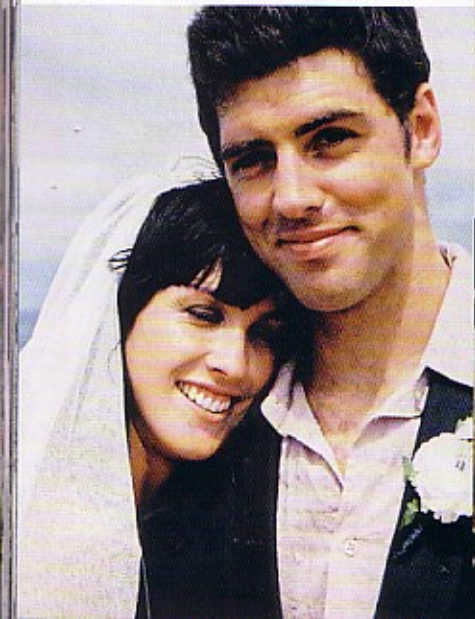
